Curriculum Content for January

Numeracy – Learning and using the old “Imperial” money system – Pounds, Shillings and Pence!! Grannies and grandpas – help very much appreciated here! Children will be learning to add and subtract “money” using this system. Arithmetic stations set up in classroom for lots of practice before our big day! Folens Mathematics tests and the 4 rules of number will continue throughout January too!

Language and Literacy – Recreating a Reading Corner in our classroom where children will all practice reading aloud in small groups in preparation for our day at the Victorian School. Class Reading – group, class, shared, paired and individual reading. Continue spelling workbooks. Reading for comprehension programme. Poem – Cosy Winter Evenings – use of metaphors & personification in poetry. Focus on Literacy English scheme. Grammar & punctuation – proof reading and editing.

The World Around Us – Continue “Life in Victorian Times”. Changes in school system. Typical life of a Victorian school child. Poor diet – preparing our “Lunch” for our day at the Causeway school. Poor hygiene. Victorian clothing in preparation for our mock school day! Learning the Bays and Headlands of the Causeway Coast.

Religion – Continue Alive-O 7 programme, Term 2 – New years resolutions. Learning all 7 sacraments. Learn the 5 Mysteries of light. Choose one modern day prophet to investigate.

PDMU – School Nurse – “ Growing & Changing” – Puberty talk. Empathising with Victorian School children – children will take on the identity of an actual Victorian child from our real Victorian register of the Causeway school. They will learn a little about the child’s background and will recreate their actual school day – clothing, lunch, schoolwork, etc.

P.E - Victorian street games.

The Arts – Learning “ Copperplate” handwriting style of Victorian children. Using ink pens and ink wells. Blotting their writing with blotting paper when complete. Writing in rhyme – similes, limericks, etc. Charcoal Pencil drawings of Victorian Artefacts.
