Dear Parents

As you will all be aware, we are in the midst of an ever changing educational climate. Part of our efforts to keep up to date with this changing climate includes trying to keep you as informed as possible about educational changes and developments.

With this in mind, we will be holding a **Curriculum Information Evening** on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> November for parents of all children from P1 - P7.
